

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED TO APPLY FOR AN ESCI-UPF SCHOLARSHIP

Applications should be submitted online. No applications will be accepted by any other means and any applications that are not duly completed in full or which fail to provide all the required supporting documentation will be rejected.

The first call for submitting applications (open to new students only) will open on 4 May and close on 30 May 2026. After this, until 3 June 2026, we will open a review period for checking the documentation and/or data provided in the submitted applications and you may be asked to amend or modify your application.

The portal for uploading applications will be published review periods.

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call for submitting applications will open on 14 September and close on 31 October 2026. After this, until 4 November 2026, we will open a review period for checking the documentation and/or data provided in the submitted applications and you may be asked to amend or modify your application. To do so, you should access the ESCI-UPF Intranet and click on the SIGMA icon in the “Institutional Grants” section.

Required documentation:

- Photocopy of ID card, passport or NIE of all members of the same household.
- Certificate of joint residence issued within the last three months.
- Full copy of the 2025 income tax return for all persons of legal age in the same household (in a single document).
- Academic transcript indicating the final average mark obtained in the Baccalaureate or Higher Vocational Training Cycle (CFGS), digitally certified by the school.

If any members of the household were not required to submit an income tax return for the previous year, they should submit the following documentation, as applicable to their specific case:

- Certificate of personal income tax details, employment record and payslips, where applicable.
- Supporting documentation accrediting them as business owners or self-employed persons.
- Certificate of income received from unemployment benefits and pensions.
