Email

SIGMA

This tool lets you manage academic details such as:

- Your enrolment

Eduroam

This international roaming service gives users in research and higher education centres easy and secure network access when visiting an institution other than their own.

You can access the <u>eduroam Wi-Fi network</u> at ESCI-UPF and other universities worldwide with the electronic credentials linked to your ESCI-UPF email account.

Office 365

All ESCI-UPF students can use their university email account to sign up for Office 365 Education for free, including Word, Excel, PowerPoint. OneNote and Microsoft Teams.
